



If you were placed in an "Indian Boarding Home Program" between September 1st, 1951 and June 30th, 1992, you may be entitled to financial compensation through the Indian Boarding Homes Class Action Lawsuit.

This class action alleges that Canada's actions in creating, operating, and maintaining the Indian Boarding Home Program created an environment where abuse, harassment, and other harms could occur. The prolonged absence from family and community also caused loss of culture, language, and community bonding. Canada's conduct was negligent and in breach of the duties that Canada owes to its Indigenous Persons.
