FirstVoices Update

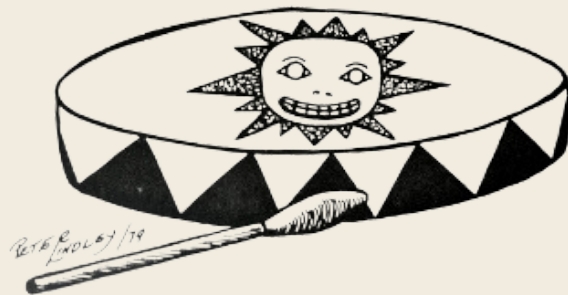
Exciting news! FirstVoices is updating its look and will be available to the public soon! The Language Technology Team is currently customizing the site before the launch of the new version.

What is the Land Use Referral Committee?

The Land Use Referral Committee is a standing Board of Lílwat Nation Chiefs and Council. The Referral Committee is responsible for:

- reviewing, assessing, and providing direction to Land and Resources Department on how to respond to land use referrals in accordance with the *Lílwat Nation Land Use Referral Consultation Policy*;
- familiarizing themselves with policies related to the title and rights of the Lílwat Nation, including, but not limited to, the *Lílwat Land Use Plan* and the *Lílwat Nation Strategic Plan*;
- representing the interests of the Lílwat Nation regarding territorial land use decisions.
