# What is a Consent Agenda?

A consent agenda is a meeting tool used to streamline routine or non-controversial items by grouping them together for approval in a single motion, without discussion. This allows meetings to focus on more strategic or complex topics with more time for discussion and debate for these topics.

Consent agenda items typically include:

- Previous meeting minutes
- Correspondence requiring no action
- Routine reports (provided for information & no further action required)
- Payments of more than \$100,000
- Administrative updates

Before the meeting, Council members receive the consent agenda materials to review.

If anyone wants to discuss an item or if an item presents a conflict of interest for a member of Council, they can request its removal, and it will be addressed separately. Otherwise, the entire consent agenda is approved in one motion.
